Stahl Memorial Aerodrome is located on Barren River in the North Industrial Park off Plum Springs Rd. The Southern Kentucky Model Aero Club is a Non-profit organization (*501(c)3 certified.*). Our purpose is the promotion and advancement in general and model aviation in particular.
